

# Half-Round Display Shelf

Cut Top, Bottom, Middle Shelf, and Back from 1/32" Mahogany (I used thin wood from cigar packaging. Sand edges smooth.

Glue Top to one edge of Back. Glue Bottom to bottom edge of Back. Glue Middle Shelf half way between Top & Bottom.

(Optional) Cut Mirrored Backing from plumber's tape or from mirrored cardstock. If you use cardstock, you will need to peel off some of the cardstock backing. Glue to Back. Smooth carefully.

Fill shelf with display items. If you glue them down with super glue, then wait an entire day before putting plastic front on as the fumes will damage the plastic.

Cut Plastic Front from 5.0 mil clear plastic. Score from top to bottom 1/16" from each end. Fold at 45 degree angle on score lines. Carefully glue one folded edge to Back at edge of cabinet (use tacky glue). Bring plastic around front of cabinet and glue other folded edge to back.

You're done.
